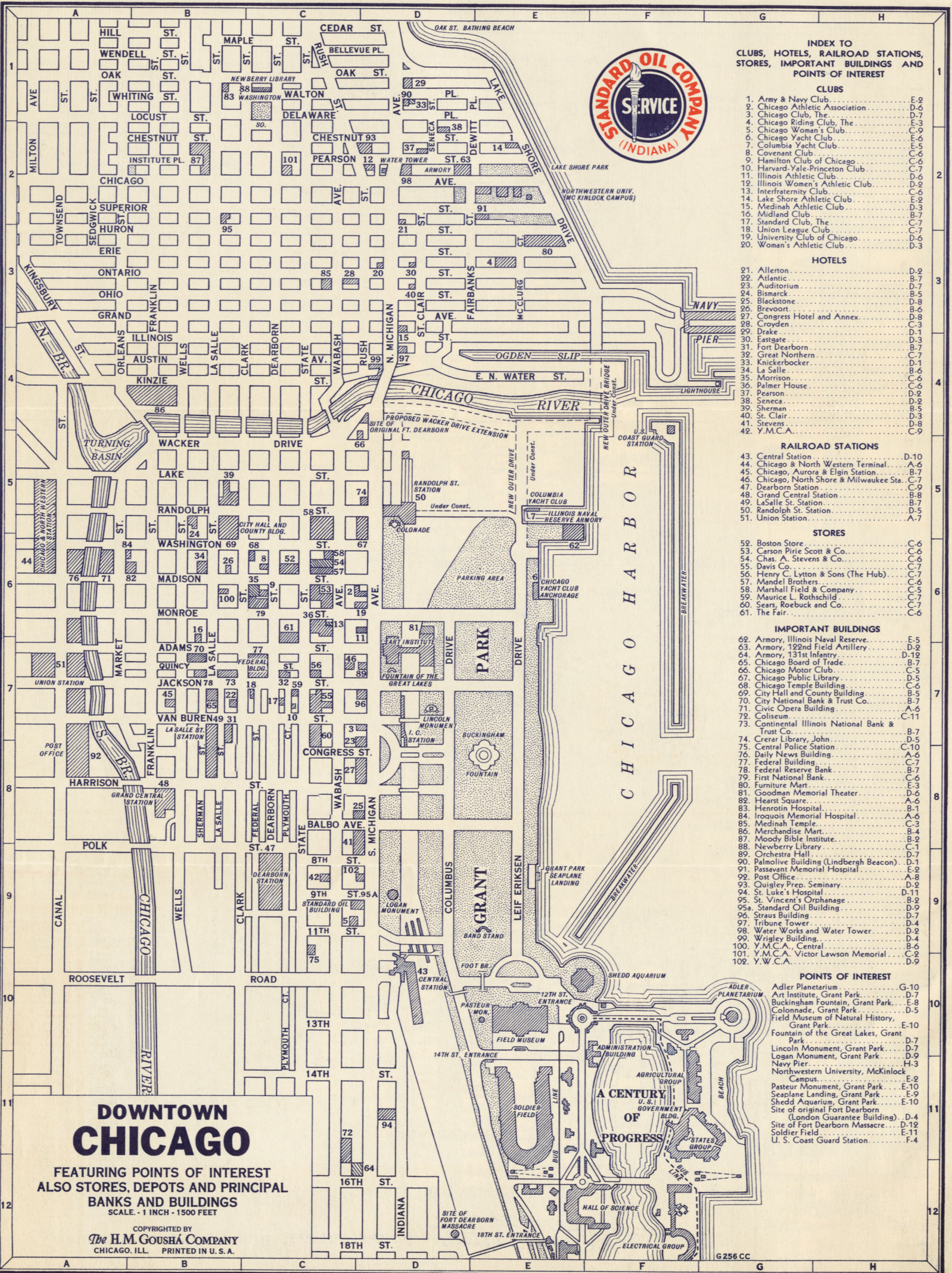
CHICAGO AND THE CENTURY OF PROGRESS EXPOSITION

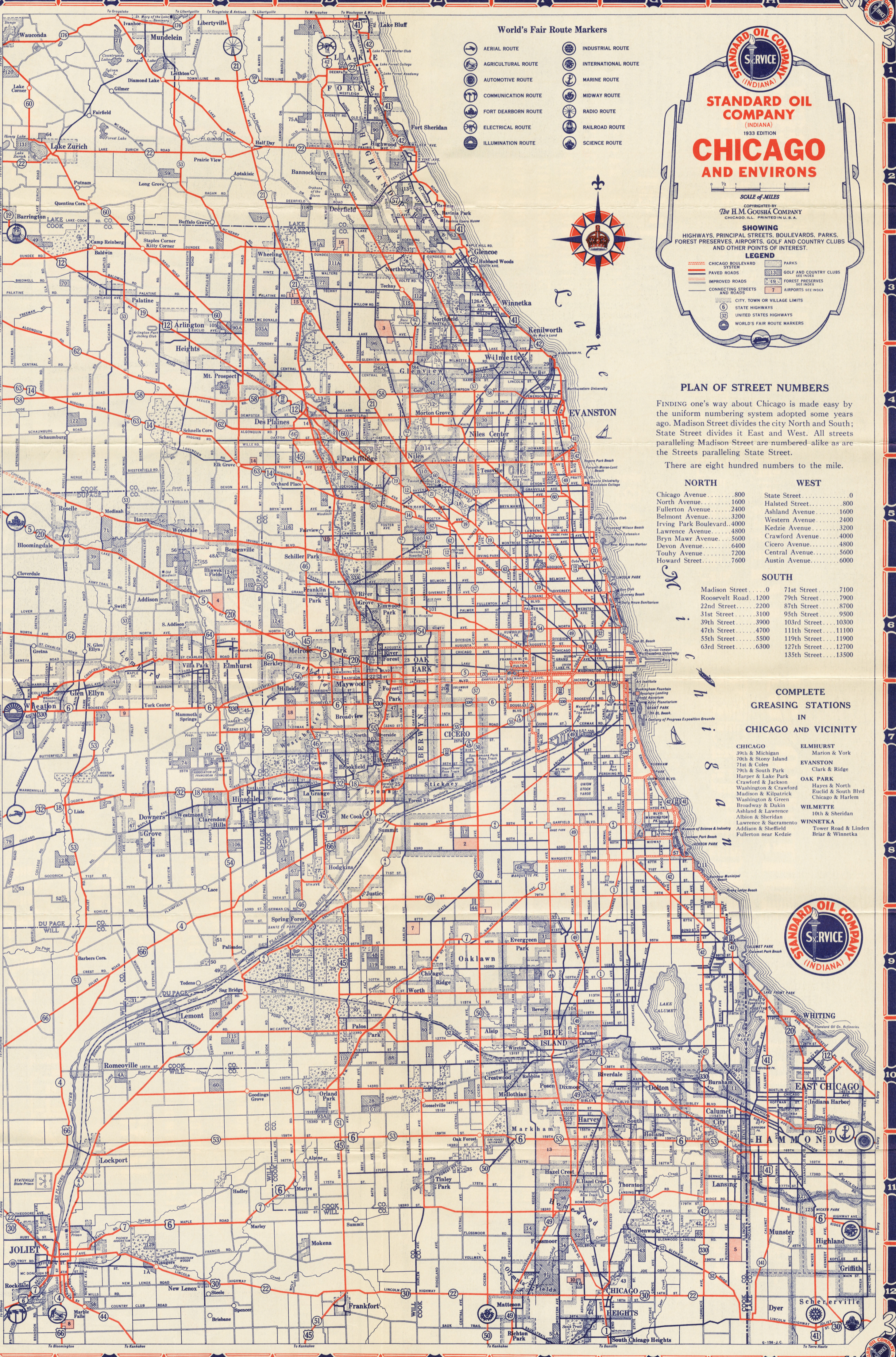
